# NumWorks Press-to-test Mode

NumWorks has a special mode that students and teachers can initiate to prepare a calculator for use in a testing environment.

This feature is called "Press-to-test." This feature temporarily disables selected applications and deletes all memory, data, and unofficial applications are deleted from the calculator.

Before testing - Enabling Press-to-test mode



1. Navigate threw the menu to go to the last application, **Settings**.
